Thank you all for your continued patience and support as we move forward into our 2020/2021 season. As we approach the new season, our commitment remains to provide an opportunity for dancers to display their talents in a fun and non-stressful competitive setting, as safe as possible.

The safety of our staff and attendees will continue to be a priority as we enter the 2020/2021 season. We are implementing new measures to ensure the safety and comfort of everyone in attendance. As the situation is constantly evolving, our practices will as well. You will receive venue-specific guidelines prior to your event. The following measures are the current policies in place. Check back for updates as this list is likely to change and evolve as new information becomes available.

1. **Sanitizing:** After each schedule block EnerGy staff will disinfect common areas such as lobby, dressing rooms and marley floor with EPA-approved medical grade disinfectant. We will wipe down all surfaces and chairs.
2. **Temperature Checks:** EnerGy staff will have daily temperature checks. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 F or above will not be permitted to attend the event. Temperature checks for all attendees may be implemented in certain areas.
3. **Limiting Spectators:** Each studio will receive wristbands to distribute to all parents/dancers/teachers that will be in attendance.
4. **Livestream:** We will livestream the competition and awards so those unable to attend can watch along.
5. **Masks:** EnerGy staff will wear masks at all times. In areas where masks are mandated in public places, they will be required for all attendees as well. The only exception is for dancers when they take the stage. As dancers prepare to take the stage they are to set their mask on a designated table. After their performance they must retrieve and put their mask back on. EnerGy staff will disinfect the table after each routine.
6. **Block Scheduling:** For the time being, we are scheduling each studio one at a time to compete. Each studio is scheduled all on one day. This way there won't be two different studios utilizing the stage, backstage area or dressing rooms simultaneously.

Thank you for your cooperation as we navigate this "new normal" in our industry. We are looking forward to getting back on stage and seeing you all in person!
